



Anderson County Fair Association, Inc. Truck Pull Rules and Classes

General Rules:

1. Owners must drive their truck to tech. Owners must present a valid driver's license to register. If the registering participant is not the owner of the vehicle, he / she must be present at the time of technical inspection and have a valid drivers license.
2. The hitch's height from the ground may not exceed 26 inches.
3. All loose articles must be secured.
4. Pull Vehicle Must have DOT approved tires. No cut tires.
5. No Nitrous or Propane!
6. Pullers must provide 4" ID or larger clevis, on truck.
7. ALL participants MUST wear seat belt.
8. Trucks must meet street legal requirements. Lift kits are acceptable, does not apply to outlaw class.
9. If they are hauled in, you WILL go into outlaw class.
10. No added weights of any kind in stock class.
11. Trucks will be inspected at gate and weighed and classed accordingly.
12. Any announcements or rules made / changed the day of the event, if needed, supersede these rules.
13. Puller will be disqualified if management is suspicious of Driver being under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
14. One passenger will be permitted in the truck when pulling.
15. All trucks must be one-ton or smaller in capacity except in outlaw class.
16. Exhaust must extend behind cab and exit through stacks in the bed or out the side or rear location.
17. Truck inspections, before or after the pull, that find violations to the rules of their Pull Class will result in an immediate disqualification of truck and driver; all registration fees will be forfeited; and all prizes will be forfeited.

General Procedures:

1. First truck out in each class can decline the distance and come back as the third puller.
2. Pull will have 2 chances to get past 75 foot marker.
3. After starting a pull, no shifting is allowed (Manual Transmission).
4. Track judge's (flaggers / officials) decision is final.
5. Pullers may buy back in one time for \$30, if time permits (decision will be made day of event).

Classes:

STREET TRUCK DIESEL

1. This must be a Stock appearing truck!
2. Programmers or chips are allowed.
3. May have after market exhaust, gauges, air box, or filter.
4. Traction Bars OK
5. No added weight of any kind.
6. Receiver style hitch required.
7. Must be driven in the gate.
8. Must have at least 1" of travel in the rear.
9. Must have a clevis with aluminum 4" opening
10. Exhaust must be no more than a haze after 100 ft. mark (No Black Smoke)

RULES APPLY TO 4WD & 2WD STOCK.

NO 4WD MAY RUN IN 2WD CLASS

10,500 LB. OUTLAW DIESEL AND OUTLAW GAS

1. Truck must weigh less than 10, 500 lbs.
2. No Nitrous or Propane.
3. Added weights accepted, but must be secure.
4. Truck must have pick up bed or flatbed, but may be a modified truck (no wreckers).

ALL PULLERS MUST HAVE CLEVIS WITH 4" OPENING
