RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Applicants must attend a school within Anderson County in grades 6-12.
- 2. Applications will be accepted through the end of May, and approval of applicants will be made by Anderson County Fair Youth Board sponsors.
- 3. Applications are found on the Anderson County Fair website under the INFO tab. Applicants should read the introductory letter and submit both the application and the waiver to: pthurmon1955@gmail.com
- 4. Applicants must be available to work at least 3-6 days the week of the fair and a few days the week prior. If this requirement is not met, the applicant will not be accepted to the Youth Board. Those exhibiting in livestock shows or the pageant should not plan to work that day.
- 5. Members are expected to show up and work their shifts as scheduled. There are to be no shift swaps the first few days and none at all without getting permission from the Youth Board Directors. Cancelling should not be undertaken lightly or AT ALL except in cases of emergency.
- 6. Members must follow all rules of Anderson County Schools and the Anderson County Fair Association or will be dismissed from the Youth Board. Membership status will be reviewed on an annual basis.
